It is not clear whether the rest at v is to left of the note A, or above it. Similarly, at \$ the rest is under the notehead of the g. (The note stems in the MS for this bar are all downward.) The last rest is shown as in the MS. I can't think of another letter to put between Sling and by's. The MS has what looks like f. Not one of those old-fashioned esses, either.
