What I at first took for a bass clef sign is, in fact, a time signature written backwards.

The note at \$ might be on the line, or above it. f might be an A or a B.

The note at v has a dot in front of the note-head, rather than after it.

End of tune marked by 4 down-up zig-zags which I have replaced with a || - PJH

Needs to be compared with the well-known Nancy Dawson.
