12b. **Oh, Joe, the Boat is Going Over** (George Craske)



Both Oscar Woods and George Craske played the chorus of the song first as an A music. The choice was then open, according to context, whether to finish at the end of a 32bar phrase, on a B music, or to finish with a chorus for people to sing along with. George Craske's playing of this tune illustrates his style of decoration, employing triplets using the button above the note (i.e the note a third above, as indicated by the mordent markings) as well as the note immediately above or below.
